RISK ASSESSMENT AND SUPERVISION

Environment (Indoors/outdoors)	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We recommend all players wear sunscreen (outdoors) and stay hydrated. Depending on the playing area, scratches can occur without long pants and covered shoes (Covered shoes are compulsory). Falling over or tripping, due to the outdoor environment, can occur. We recommend players wear outdoor appropriate clothing, Covered/closed shoes are compulsory. Supervise all players while equipment is in use. Ensure that all players are aware of their surroundings prior to play. Hazards are looked for and identified if any exist in the arena.
People (Collision)	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10 people maximum in each team, 2 teams at once. Mix teams to ensure a close even match between players. Area of operation to be roped off and restricted access to spectators. Closed in shoes to be worn at all times. Listen to operator. No running. Be careful around the barriers. Inclusive of tree's and other obstructions. Ensure that all players are supervised when playing. One supervisor/operator ensuring appropriate play at all times. Ensure the playing area is large enough for the number of players. Ensure all players are aware of their surroundings prior to the beginning of the games.
Barriers (if used) may fall / collide into	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our aluminum tube barriers are made from light aluminium and corflute panels weigh approximately 1200 grams each. The size is 1.2mx1.8m x2 in an L shape. Players should not attempt to move or jump over barrier. Barriers are pegged down with 22 cm tent pegs outdoors. Should a barrier fall upon someone, the likelihood of injury is minimal. Should a participant collide with a barrier, the barrier is designed to cave and bend rather than cause injury.
Injured from Tagger Use	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The taggers use harmless infrared light (Just like a TV remote control). No additional safety equipment is required. Taggers Must be held with two hands. To prevent dropping. Closed Shoes are required also for this reason.
